

Justice Desk Africa are currently seeking experienced facilitators to join two of our projects, which work with young children challenging all forms of gender-based violence.

Project Facilitator Requirements

Projects specific details:

- **Mbokodo Club:** which focuses on empowering girl children survivors of rape and gender-based violence.
- **iNtsika YeThemba:** which focuses on mentoring young boys to become women's rights defenders and challenge toxic masculinity.

Details and Expectations:

- **Frequency:** 20 session a year
- **Venue:** Herschel High School, Claremont (Mbokodo) and 12 York Rd, Greenpoint (iNtsika)
- **Time:** 9am - 12pm (3 hours)
- **Session Dates:** Every second Saturday
- **Other requirements:** To be able to attend 3 days of in-person trainings to prepare for the job, and must be able to attend team meetings once a week in the evenings virtually.

Facilitator requirements:

- Must be able to speak isiXhosa and/or Afrikaans fluently
- Must have brilliant facilitating skills
- Must have previous experience facilitating sessions with children
- Must be able to organise their own transport
- Must be able to commit to joining all 20 sessions in the year
- Must have an ability to run empowerment workshops with the kids on various topics, such as Human Rights, Gender-based Violence, toxic masculinity, etc.
- Must be able to help with session planning, to create games & activities to teach the kids in a fun & interactive way.

Remuneration of R1000 per facilitator per session. This fee includes the 3 hours on session days, the 1-hour evening team meeting every 2 weeks, and transport and food.
